How to Use

Do not use on Aluminum.

Floor Stripping	Use one part CERT to 10 parts warm water to remove polish film
Floor Cleaning	Use one part CERT to 50 parts warm water to clean all unsealed flooring surfaces, such as vinyl, concrete, ceramic and metal tiles.
Steam Cleaning	Use one part CERT to 80 parts water.
Defatting Agent	Use one part CERT to 40 parts water to remove fat from walls, floors, tablets and machinery in areas such as food processing plants, kitchens, canteens and abattoirs.
Oven Cleaning	Heat oven to 50oC and then turn off. Use CERT neat and apply to oven . Allow to work for 5 to 10 minutes on the warm surface. Wipe off with a damp cloth, sponge or paper towel.
Hot Plates	Squirt CERT onto warm hot plate (50°C). Agitate with scourer or scraper then rinse off with portable water. It is advisable to seal hot plate after cleaning with a small amount of butter or margarine other the hot plate may corrode. Note: Do not use on a HOT oven or grill plate – turn the appliance off and allow to cool before using.
Rest Room Cleaner	Use one part CERT to 30 parts water to clean porcelain surfaces, bathroom fixtures, walls, tiles and grout.
General Maintenance	Use one part CERT to 50 parts water to clean all hard surfaces such as cupboards, bench tops, glass, chrome, stainless steel, painted surfaces and enamel.
